- Flash presenters may use one or two slides to promote their poster.
- The aim is to attract people to your poster.
- A company or institution logo is permitted in the footer.



File Name

- Save your file with your session number as a prefix. For example:
- **Session Number:** P.1
- **Author:** Author Name

90 Second Presentation Duration

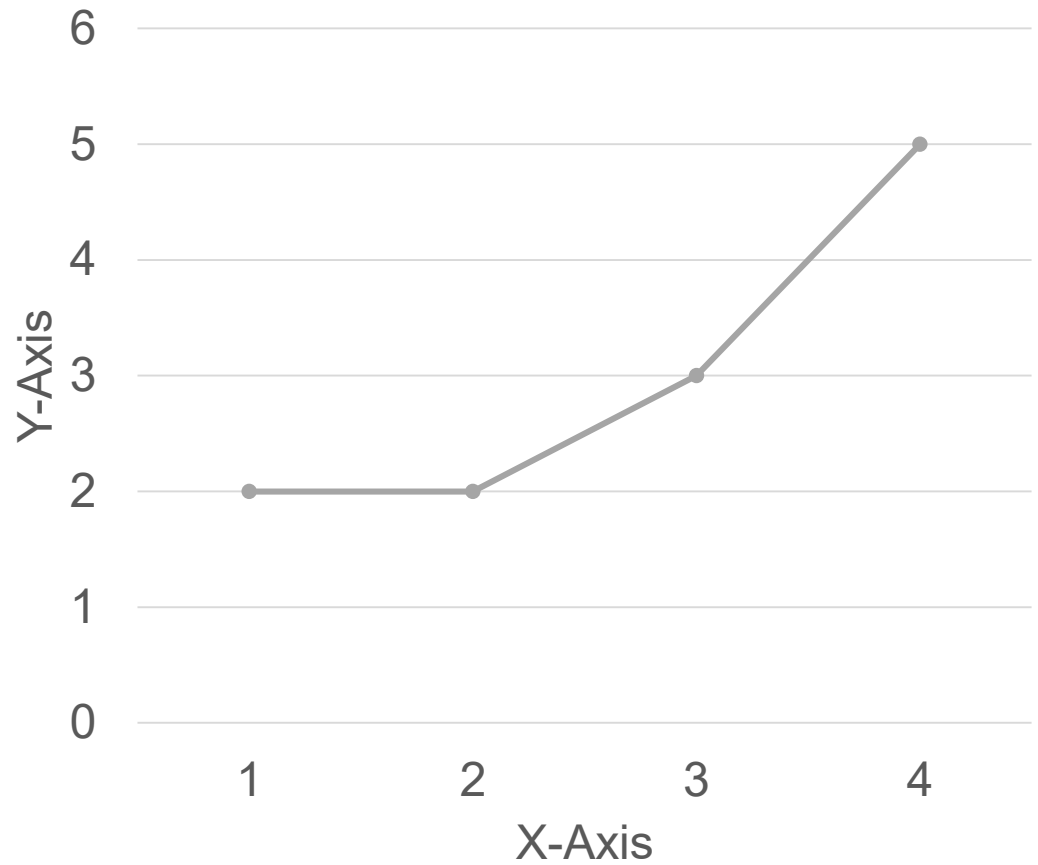
- Each presenter of a “flash presentation” has a 1 ½ minute slot.
- Please practice it to ensure it is not longer than this duration.

Logo, Background and Borders

- **Corporate and institutional logos are permitted only in the slide footer.**
- **Corporate and institutional backgrounds and borders are not permitted.**
- Backgrounds must be white.
- Text, lines, and shape outlines must be dark.

Slide Title in 36-44pt

- Arial text in 24pt
- For diagrams, plots & graphs:
 - Minimum font size for text is 20pt.
 - Please ensure all font sizes in X & Y axes titles & diagram labels are ≥ 18 pt to be seen clearly at the back of the room.
 - Any slides with text smaller than these limits will be asked to be updated.



Slide Content Instructions

- This is an example of an inappropriate slide.
- For slides with text only, use no more than 30 words per slide and no more than 6 lines of text per slide.
- For illustrations, make all lines, numbers, and captions of sufficient thickness and size so that they are projected clearly.
- Often graphical data that are imported from another application have inadequate line width and font size to be useful. If necessary, re-draw the material using native PowerPoint graphics & ensure the font size is readable and meeting the sizes shown on previous slide.
- Use duplicate copies of slides that will be used more than once during the presentation. Do not plan to move back to previously shown slides during the presentation.

Colours

- If using coloured text: try to use **red**, **blue** & **yellow** first as some people are **red/green** colour blind.

16:9 Format

- Please ensure you use 16:9 slide size and not 4:3.

File Format

- Electronic projection will be used for all technical papers & flash presentations.
- • The projection computers will run the following software:
 - Microsoft Windows 10, Microsoft PowerPoint, and Adobe Reader.
- **Presentation slides must be provided in either PowerPoint or PDF format.**
